Re: Annual Notification to Parents  
Additions and Changes

Each year Schools Legal Service updates the suggested Annual Notice to Parents appearing on our web page at [www.schoolslegalservice.org](http://www.schoolslegalservice.org) in the "Members Only" section. This year the changes for required parental notices are so few that we simply list them here.

Student records may be used to identify and verify eligibility for certain services under the federal No Child Left Behind Act.

Students with doctor authorization may carry and self-administer auto-injectable epinephrine medications.

Outside instructors may be involved with AIDS/HIV programs.

Parents may exempt students from the health component of any course or class if that instruction conflicts with a parent's religious training or beliefs.

Corresponding changes are indicated in bold text in the affected items on our recommended notice list.
